

FOR THE UK VISA APPLICANTS

All applicants in Thailand wishing to come to the United Kingdom for a period longer than six months need to obtain a certificate confirming that they are free from infectious tuberculosis (TB) before submitting their visa application. The categories of applicant that are affected include long-term students, Points Based System Tier 2 and Tier 5 workers (longer than 6 months), other employment and domestic workers, volunteer workers (plus all dependents of the aforementioned), and all settlement and marriage cases, including fiancé(e)s or proposed civil partners. Please note that those failing to submit a certificate at the time of application will be refused and the visa fee will not be refunded.

An IOM Medical Certificate will be provided for all applicants, regardless of age, who are free of infectious tuberculosis and who are applying for visa to come to the United Kingdom for a period longer than six months.

The following applicants will be exempted from the TB test:

All diplomatic passport holders being posted to the United Kingdom

IOM operating hours

IOM is open from Monday to Friday, except for the IOM holidays.

Working hours: Monday – Thursday 08:00 - 17:00 hours and Friday 08:00-14:30 hours.

Registration Time: Monday – Thursday 08:00 - 15:00 hours and Friday 08:00-13:30 hours.

Required Documents

1. Original passport for all applicants.
2. Original passport or ID card of a parent or a legal guardian with the Power of Attorney from a parent for children under 18 years. (Children under 18 years must be accompanied by a parent or a legal guardian who can sign and make decision on their behalf)
3. Ante-Natal Care Book for pregnant women.
4. Original TB certificate for previous applicants whose certificate is still valid.

Procedures

All applicants will have to undergo interview with a physician and answer questions about their health.

For applicants of 11 years of age and above, the medical TB detection procedure consists of:

- Register, take a photo, sign consent form and pay the fee at IOM clinic from 8:00-12:00 hours and 13:00-15:00 hours.
- Undergo Chest X-ray at Bangkok Christian Hospital or Phyathai 2 Hospital after registration.
- Take the Chest X-ray result back to IOM office on the same day.
- See the IOM physician.
- Sputum testing is required only if TB is suspected.
- A certificate is issued at IOM clinic if there is no evidence of TB.

For applicants below 11 years of age, the medical TB detection procedure consists of:

- Register, take a photo, sign consent form and pay the fee at IOM clinic from 8:00-12:00 hours and 13:00-15:00 hours.
- See the IOM physician.
- If indicated, further evaluation such as Chest X-ray or Sputum Test for TB.
- A certificate is issued at IOM clinic if there is no evidence of TB.

Pregnant applicant

A pregnant applicant has 3 options:

- Having a chest X-ray with double shielding in the 2nd and 3rd trimesters. It is not recommended to take chest X-ray during the first trimester; Or
- Provide sputum specimens in a designated laboratory for smear and culture without going through chest X-ray. (Sputum will be collected in the morning hours for 3 consecutive days. The testing with sputum culture takes at least 8 (eight) weeks.); Or
- Postpone chest X-ray (and TB clearance) until after delivery.

Sputum Testing by IOM Laboratory

If chest X-ray is abnormal (presenting changes suggestive of an active or inactive TB process) or if there are other clinical reasons to suspect TB disease, the applicant will be referred for sputum testing. **The sputum collection must commence within 7 days of Chest X-ray.** Sputum will be collected in the morning hours for three consecutive days. Sputum smears and sputum cultures will be done which takes at least 8 (eight) weeks for result.

***Sputum MUST be given first thing in the early morning. DO NOT have breakfast or any drinks except clean water.**

Results and certification

Certificate will be issued on the same day if chest x-ray findings or clinical findings do not warrant sputum testing.

Fees

- Applicants of 11 years of age and above: **THB 3,800** (Three Thousand and Eight Hundred Thai Baht) per person.
- Applicants below 11 years of age, not requiring further evaluation: **THB 500** (Five Hundred Thai Baht) per person.
- Applicants below 11 years of age, requiring further evaluation: **THB 3,800** (Three Thousand and Eight Hundred Thai Baht) per person.

Payment Methods

- To be paid by cash at IOM office during registration.
- Prepaid payment at SCB bank before your appointment date - You can download the payment form via [Health Assessment and Travel Assistance | IOM Thailand](#)

Spouses and children applying under the Family Reunion (for refugees and those with humanitarian protection) do not need to pay the fee at IOM; please check with the British Embassy.

We strongly advise you to read these guidance notes in order to successfully complete the registration.

Step 1 Main Information

1. Country of Assessment: Please select “Thailand”

2. Visa Type

Please check one of the following

- Other
- Settlement and Dependents
- Student with Scholarship (For student who got scholarship from UK Government only)
- Student without Scholarship
- Work

3. Last (Family) Name: This is the name by which your family is known and must be the one shown in your passport. Please do not use titles such as Mr or qualifiers such as Snr (Senior), Esq (Esquire). Please copy the name from the passport without changing spelling.

4. First Name: These are the names you were given at birth, or subsequently, for example your Confirmation name, and patronymic. Do not include your family name or any nicknames. They must be the same as recorded in your passport. Please do not use titles such as Mr or qualifiers such as Snr (Senior), Esq (Esquire). Please copy the name from the passport without changing spelling.

5. Middle Name Please copy the name from the passport without changing spelling. If you do not have a middle name on your passport, leave this field blank, Do not enter “-”, “Not applicable” or “N/A”.

6. Full Name as in the passport: The applicant’s name in his native language (write using Thai alphabet) if you are not a Thai citizen, leave this field blank.

7. Gender: select Male/Female

8. Date of birth in dd/mm/yyyy format. This is how the date is recorded in your passport.

Step 2 Secondary Information

1. Country of Nationality : This is the nationality shown in the passport/travel document you wish to use with this application.

2. Citizen ID. If you are not Thai citizen, leave this field blank.

3. Passport Number: This number should be the one shown in the passport you wish to use.

4. Passport Issue Date: In dd/mm/yyyy format

5. Passport Expiry Date: In dd/mm/yyyy format

6. Permanent Address: You MUST provide your full address details, including house number or name, street, village/town/city, state/province, and country.

Example: 120 Kasemkij Building, Silom Road, Bangrak, Bangkok, Thailand

7. Present address: You will be contacted at this address if your contact details are different from the permanent address.

8. Primary Phone Number: Mobile/cellular telephone number. **Example:** 0811234567

9. Secondary Phone Number: Home (landline) telephone number. **Example:** 022347950

10. Other Telephone Number (If have)

11. Email: This can be at home, work or elsewhere, but must be the one you use on a regular basis so we can contact you quickly.

Step 3 UK Contact details

1. Address in UK : You MUST provide your full address details, including house number or name, street, village/town/city, state/province, if you do not have the address in UK please enter “-”

2. Postcode in UK

3. Telephone in UK (Please fill “-” if do not have).

4. Applicant is being sponsored to come to the UK: Sponsor when you stay in United Kingdom. In case of applicant apply for settlement and dependent, please fill name and address of sponsor in United Kingdom. For student visa and other types of visa, if you doesn't have sponsor in United Kingdom please fill “No”.

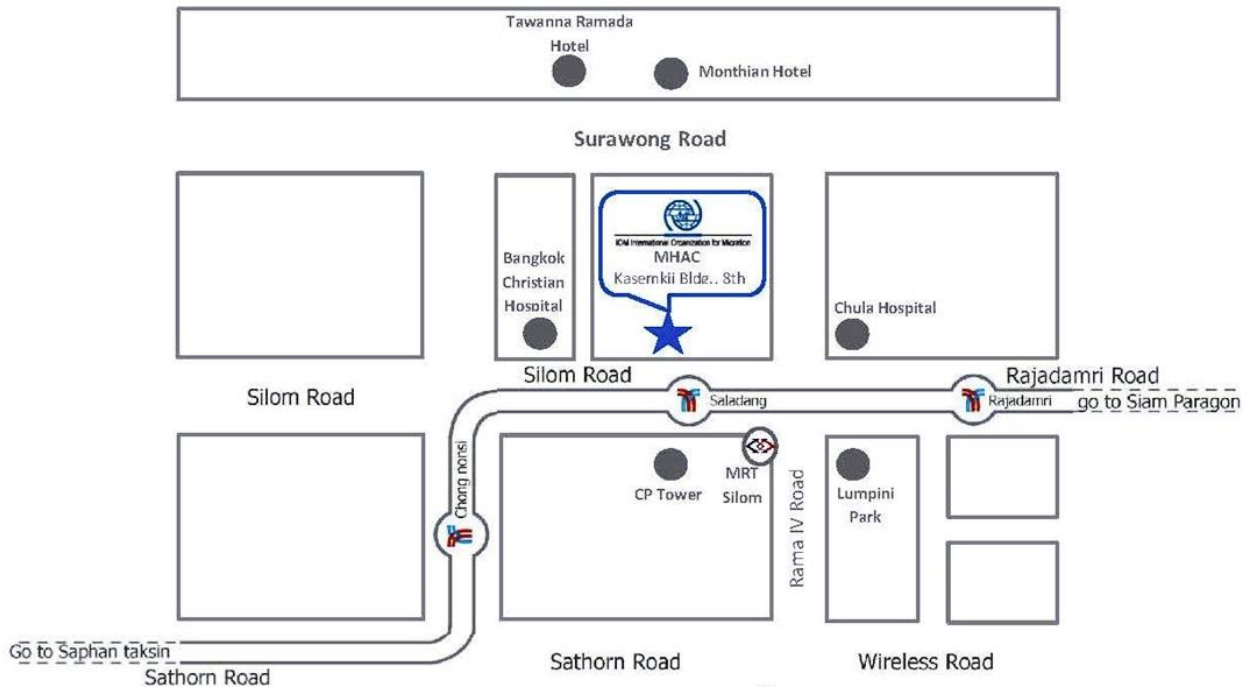
